The April meeting will be a presentation on Electrical Safety and the experience of an arc flash survivor. MJ Electric is sponsoring our April speaker—David Schury.

Tragedy to Triumph Foundation was created by David Schury, a 34 year employee of Commonwealth Edison, the electric com-

pany in Chicago. In April 13, 2000, an event happened that changed his life forever and led to the creation of the Foundation.

On that day, in a substation in Chicago, a rat chewed a wire, short-circuiting a 12,000-volt piece of equipment causing an explosion. In the blink of an eye, Dave was burned over 30% of his body. He spent the next two weeks fighting for his life in the burn unit at Cook County Hospital.
